Workshop & Special Event Descriptions

Basic Computer Skills: These days, it's important for everyone to have basic computer skills. Join this LIVE workshop to learn the basics, including creating a Gmail account and sending an email, basic word processing, how to search the internet and more. Seats are limited. Reservation is required.

Whether you are new to yoga or have taken classes, this is the best place for you to start. Yoga is a unique way of strengthening and toning the body. Registration is required.

Becoming Your Best Self: In this VIRTUAL workshop, you will learn how to build a life that you don't need to escape. How? By balancing your time, taking risks, cultivating your courage, and doing the things that you love and enjoy.

Book Club: One of the pleasures of reading a good book is then having a discussion to rave about it or a lively debate about participants' reactions to what they've read. Join us for your Connection to the literary world as we discuss our shared experiences of our selected book.

Building Blocks: This is a weekly program for children that features storytime, arts & crafts, music or an appearance by a PNC Grow Up Great[®] partner. Ages 3 to 6.

Computers 101: Join this 8-week program that will provide you with an introduction to laptops and desktops, understanding mobile apps, and safe internet navigation. This workshop is designed to help seniors and adults learn computer basics.

Families in the Kitchen: Learn as you participate in a health & wellness workshop by discussing recipes and the nutritional value of the food that is prepared by our very own Chef Tiffani of Cutting Board Academy. We'll bring dinner, you bring your family! Great opportunity to meet friends, visit with neighbors, learn new recipes and spend quality time with your family.

Financial Empowerment for Young Adults: This is a workshop where students will learn to explore personal financial choices, make informed financial decisions, and consider what it means to be financially responsible. This month's theme is Setting Financial Goals.

Get Up & Groove: Family Line Dancing Night: Join us for a fun night of line dancing! Our instructor will teach you all the moves you need to get grooving and moving to the best hits. This event is open to all ages so bring the whole family down for a night of line dancing and movement at the Connection. No experienced required.
