Workshop & Special Event Descriptions

The Art of Crochet: Learn the fundamentals of crochet. Participants will learn basic crochet stitches and how to read a crochet pattern while creating their own crochet pieces.

Black History 365: Juneteenth: Celebrate, learn, and connect with Black History 365! This monthly program offers inspiring discussions, hands-on activities, and cultural experiences for all ages. Together, we'll explore the past, embrace the present, and build a brighter future!

Book Club: One of the pleasures of reading a good book is discussing it with others who have read it. Join the club to rave about what you've just read or to debate participants' various reactions to the book. Connect with us as we discuss our shared experiences surrounding the book.

Budgeting Made Simple: In this workshop, participants will understand the value of creating a budget and learn strategies to build a simple budget and pay off debt.

Building Blocks: This is a weekly program for children that features story-time, arts & crafts, music or an appearance by a PNC Grow Up Great® partner. Ages 3–6.

Canva Creations: In this hands-on workshop, you'll dive into Canva to create posters, social media graphics and other cool projects. Learn simple design tricks, play with colors and fonts, and bring your creative ideas to life in a fun, relaxed space for creators.

Canva Video 2.0: Learn a straightforward, Canva-based workflow to turn raw clips into polished, professional-looking videos—no complex software required. You'll apply layout, typography, pacing, and brand consistency so your content feels intentional and on-brand. Create one video and quickly adapt it for social media, presentations, promos, and short-form platforms in just minutes.

Cleveland Museum of Art Family Workshop: Celebrate creativity and community with Studio Go, the Cleveland Museum of Art's mobile art van, as it rolls down to the Connection for a fun family workshop! Join us for a hands-on art-making workshop with a project inspired by Juneteenth.

Community Compass: Come join our program where community comes together to discuss local issues, inspire one another, exchange ideas, and strengthen our ties through shared connections and greater understanding.

Computers 101: This 8-week program will provide you with an introduction to laptops and desktops, understanding mobile apps, and safe internet navigation. This workshop is designed to help seniors and adults learn basic computer skills.

Walk away with practical skills to create polished, engaging videos from start to finish.
